In the few months since we joined Hulen Street Baptist Church, Jody has organized a Missions Fair, held 2 different Passport Signup Events, taken a group to Germany on a mission trip, gotten several members to participate in the Bill Glass Prison Ministry, organized and led a mission trip to Mexico and took several from Hulen Street to Vinnitsa, Ukraine. The church is turning a corner as it embarks on a new focused involvement in missions for every member and we are excited to be a part of it.

#### Report on Winter Eastern Europe Ministries

We continue to partner with Michael Gott International as we conduct English Language Evangelism events in Easter Europe. "If it ain't broke, don't fix it!" It is overwhelming to be a part of this ministry that God has clearly chosen to use as a tool for reaching these formerly communist countries. We held one 2-week event in Vinnitsa, Ukraine. Out of over 900 registered students in the school there were approximately

600 decisions for Christ. Until you have seen God work through this venue, you cannot believe it. Jody stayed an additional 2 weeks to direct another English Language Evangelism Event in Kiev, Ukraine. Of the 900 registered students, approximately 530 gave their hearts to Christ. It took about 40 lay volunteers each giving two-weeks of their winter to teach English, make friends, and directly share Christ.

Follow-up teams of missionaries stationed in those cities will continue the work by conducting English Bible studies, English classes, integrating the new Christians into churches and forming new congregations.

cepted Christ this winter have a unique and special story.

One of these was a mother of 4 children, named Elena. She chose to go by one of the English versions of her name in class, Helen, since it was an English school. Helen was a tired, timid woman who was skeptical that she would be able to learn any English. Her children were beginning to learn some English at school and she wanted to be able to help them. Since the class was free, she thought she had nothing to lose. Helen ended up in Trisha's class, a basic class for students who speak absolutely no English at all. Helen was very self-conscious and wasn't sure that she would come back for the second class. Trisha encouraged her and the others. At the end of class, Trisha gave Helen a little hug and told her that she'd done a great job. Trisha noticed a tear in the corner of Helen's eye. The second day Helen came back, just as terrified, but she was there. Each day, with lots of encouragement, Helen attempted to repeat the English words her teacher was saying. A few days later, Trisha gave Russian Bibles to each student. As Helen re-

ceived hers, she began to sob. Later she explained through a translator that she had always wanted a Bible. Helen said that she had prayed that very morning that somehow she would be able to get a Bible. She thought it might have some answers for her life. By the end of the school, Helen had seen the love of Christ through her teacher and others. She clearly heard the gospel and prayed to receive Christ as her personal Savior.

Twenty-five adults and youth from Hulen Street Baptist Church joined with Jody to conduct VBS, women's Bible study and evening evangelism services in Reynosa, Mexico during the Spring Break. The most important result was that 12 adults and dozens of children accepted Christ. Pastor Saul, our host, will work hard to integrate these new believers into his church. These short-term trips have proven to be a very effective way to introduce adults and teens to direct, evangelistic missions.
