Our Practically Speaking Business English course is a hit in Belarus

Minsk, Belarus - The evangelistic Business English Course was conducted February 5 through 9th. This was perhaps the finest course we've ever done. Of the students that completed the course, 148 indicated on our questionnaire that they had prayed to receive Christ as their Lord and Savior. In this course there was no translation and the students were required to have an intermediate or advanced ability in English.

The comments from the students indicated that this course reached a new level of excellence for us. Some even said that they were paying for a business English course that was very much inferior to our course. We're happy that the students benefited from the course but our great joy comes from knowing their lives were changed by the presentation of the Gospel both from the examples of the teachers and the preaching of the word of God.

Appreciation goes to the team composed of men and women from Celebration Church and New Bethany Baptist Church (both of Buford, GA) and Hulen Street Baptist Church (Fort Worth, TX). Thanks also go to our partners in Minsk, Joe and Alesia Wilson and Oleg Rachkovski who prepared everything in advance and will coordinate the follow-up effort.

Our Practically Speaking English Courses Reached Hundreds in Nicaragua

Managua, Nicaragua - During the first four weeks of 2007, over 700 adults and 400 children participated in these two-week events. More than 400 people indicated that they had prayed to receive Christ as their Lord and savior.

We debuted the new Practically Speaking English for Children and almost 200 children and many parents attended each event. Many of the parents who accompanied their children responded to the gospel message along with dozens and dozens of children. Appreciation goes to the children's teams from Greenbriar Baptist Church (Alvarado, TX) and Hulen Street Baptist Church (Fort Worth).

In the adult course, more than 700 practiced conversational English and heard the gospel message. Of those, 298 indicated on our questionnaire that they had prayed to receive Christ as their Lord and Savior. Dallas - Fort Worth, TX - Our partnership with Bill Glass Champions for Life continues to reward us with the privilege of sharing Christ here in the DFW metroplex as well as across the U.S. Jody was assigned as coordinator for the team of almost 30 teammates that ministered in the Henry Wade Juvenile Detention Center (Dallas, TX) during the recent DFW Weekend of Champions. Fort Worth, TX - The "Retta Rockers" (senior adult group) of Retta Baptist Church has been preparing teammate packets for the Bill Glass Champions for Life prison events for the past four years. Last week they prepared more than 1,500 packets that teammates will use in ministering to men and women inmates across the U.S. By our estimate, the "Retta Rockers" have stuffed more than 12,000 packets in the last four years. Statistically, each packet represents 1 or more first time decisions for Christ and 1 or more decision for assurance or recommitment.

In the meantime, through sponsorships from our supporters, we continue to to help feed and clothe the 39 children living in the Diaz private home.
